The next Work Party will be on September 22nd at 9:00 a.m. Please bring your tools, especially hammers. Thanks!

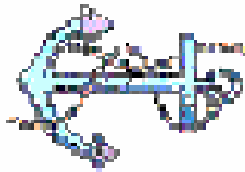

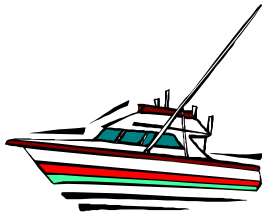


BUNCO

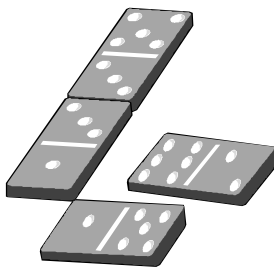

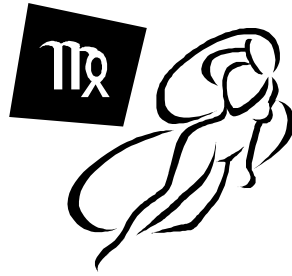
